## **Edward Deak, Ph.D Fairfield University**

*Dr. Deak is the Roger M. Lynch Professor of Economics and Chairman of the Department of Economics at Fairfield University. He is also a Board Member and the Connecticut Forecast Manager for the New England Economic Partnership. In 2007, Connecticut Governor M. Jodi Rell named Dr. Deak to the Governor's Economic Advisory Council, an eight member panel of leading economists from throughout the state to advise her on key issues affecting the Connecticut economy.*

*Dr. Deak published a book, "The Economics of e-Commerce and the Internet" in which he tackles misconceptions about the economics of the Internet. He testified on the Y2K problem before the U.S. Senate Committee on Financial Services and Technology.*
